Another original Facsimile Font for photolettering designed by Joe Taylor for FotoStar International. Probably one of the most pirated fonts available.

This font was designed to be used on a Capitol Records album featuring an actor who was impersonating W. C. Fields. The font has its derivation from the German font Koloss, designed by Jakob Erbar and also released by Facsimile Fonts converted from the original metal type owned by Bob Trogman.
